MOLECULE WITH A TWIST

The Gene Technology Access Centre in Melbourne is bringing their program “Molecule with a Twist” to BSSC next term on Thursday 15th and Friday 16th April. All students studying Biology Units 3 and 4 will have an opportunity to attend a lecture and a laboratory session. In this program students will attend an explanatory lecture on the structure of DNA, and the application of DNA to forensic science. In the laboratory session the students will be able to see some of the techniques used in DNA analysis. This will be a fantastic experience for students to see real scientists in action and there is no charge for this program. Biology students will be given more details about the program by their Biology teacher. Other interested students who are free between 11.10am and 12.30 pm are most welcome to attend the lecture in James King Hall.
