## Scholarship Snapshot

<b>Overview</b>	The scholarship aims to assist high achieving and highly motivated local students who have been offered a full-time place at an Australian university, TAFE institute or college for the first time to study at <b>undergraduate bachelor's degree first year level</b> and are experiencing financial and/or social challenges.
<b>Faculty</b>	All
<b>Study area</b>	All
<b>Scholarship type</b>	Need based, Merit based
<b>Year of study</b>	<b>First year undergraduate bachelor's degree</b>
<b>Duration</b>	One year initially but may be awarded for up to two years (dependent upon academic performance)
<b>Intention of Scholarship</b>	Study related expenses including accommodation and course costs, study related materials/equipment, text books, tutoring and/or educational related travel (within Australia)
<b>Award Value</b>	\$3,000 (per annum) per student
<b>Eligibility</b>	To be eligible the student must meet the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must reside in Heathcote, Redesdale, Mia Mia, Tooborac, Pyalong, Costerfield, Knowsley or Axedale.</li> <li>• must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident</li> <li>• must be a first-time, <b>first year undergraduate</b> in 2019 (first attendance at an Australian University or TAFE at bachelor's degree level)</li> <li>• must be <b>studying a full-time bachelor's degree</b> on campus at an Australian university, TAFE Institute or college (in an approved Australian course)</li> <li>• must have completed Year 12</li> <li>• must be aged 25 years or younger as at 30 January 2019</li> <li>• should be able to demonstrate community involvement</li> <li>• should be able to demonstrate the challenges (financial and/or social) which are hindering the student's ability to undertake further study</li> <li>• should be academically motivated.</li> </ul>
<b>Nationality</b>	Australian citizen or permanent resident
<b>Application dates</b>	OPEN: 3 December 2018 CLOSE: 29 January 2019
<b>How to apply</b>	Applications are invited from 3 December 2018 and can only be submitted online. Please visit <a href="http://bendigobank.com.au/scholarships">bendigobank.com.au/scholarships</a> for more information from this date.
<b>Criteria</b>	Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of a selection committee and will be based on how an applicant addresses the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Academic achievement</li> <li>• Financial and/or social challenges</li> <li>• Evidence of leadership and citizenship within their communities</li> </ul>
