Educational items for students to own

The college will provide parents/carers with a list of educational items that you can choose to purchase from *a third-party provider* for your student to individually own and use. There are many advantages to students owning materials for personal use rather than a shared arrangement. Where parents/carers would like to purchase these items they can do this through our current Booklist Supplier, Education Plus (www.edplus.com.au) who provide the following items:

- Textbooks
- Stationery
- Technology & Art Kits
- Consumables
- Calculators and
- Other classroom subject resources

There are also a range of second-hand book opportunities available through online communities. A list of texts and resources appropriate to buy can be found on the BSSC Second-hand books Facebook page where items can also be purchased.

The following three categories are used by the Department of Education as a reference for schools to outline the types of voluntary payments available and the associated items in this document are colour coded accordingly.

1. Curriculum Contributions

These include items and activities that students use, or participate in, to access the Curriculum and Educational Items such as Textbooks, Calculators, Stationery, Art Kits, compulsory curriculum camps and excursions and learning resources.

2. Other Contributions

Non-Curriculum items and activities to support the daily operation and objectives of Bendigo Senior Secondary College and to support students and school programs. This includes: ID card, print credits, high speed internet, Compass and ICT & BYOD Support.

Tax deductible contributions made per family towards Bendigo Senior Secondary College's:

- Building Fund (to support renovations, upgrades, and maintenance of school infrastructure)
- School Library (to support book purchases and other equipment that sustain the library as a valuable resource)

3. Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Bendigo Senior Secondary College offers a range of items and activities on a user-pays basis. These include a range of excursions, costs associated with the ADP and the purchase of our college Magazine.

Vocational Educational Training (VET)

From 2022, the Department will reimburse VET <u>material fees</u> to the college to address the cost barrier for families. This funding covers the costs of:

- Materials required for training and assessment that are consumed and cannot be recycled. Please
 note students may wish to upgrade materials for certain projects (i.e. upgrade from pine to
 mahogany). Any upgrade from the materials provided by BSSC is considered an OPTIONAL ITEM, as
 per the description above.
- Safety items worn or used by the student including hearing protection, gloves, hair nets.
- Workbooks, handouts, photocopying, online learning resources
- Class sets, intended to be returned and retained by the school, such as textbooks, tools, tool belts, specialist knives, aprons



However, this funding <u>does not</u> cover all costs associated with the facilitation of VET classes. The payment of the following items is supported by Voluntary Financial Contributions from families:

- Transport costs and hire of specialized facilities required for training or assessment
- Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) worn and retained by the student
- Online registration/subscription fees, platform charges, software
- Tuition fees, registration, and administration fees
- Tools upgrade or purchase initiated by the parent

Financial Support for Families

Bendigo Senior Secondary College understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund provides payments for eligible students to attend camps, sports, and excursions
- Instalment payment arrangements The College appreciates that there can sometimes be financial difficulties experienced by parents and carers in meeting requests for payments and contributions. A range of support options are available through the college.

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

• Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

 Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
