Non-scheduled class time

At BSSC, we have some time on our timetable that is not scheduled for class time (see adjacent timetable). This time allows for students to access their teachers for 1:1 or small group support, to attend study support sessions, revision presentations and catch-up practical class.

At various times throughout the year, students will be scheduled into **School Assessed Coursework (SACs)** and if behind in classes, into compulsory Redemption
Sessions. It is therefore very important that students realise their daily commitment is from 9.00am-3.30pm and they do not make other arrangements at this time.

All students should fully utilise the opportunities that are available to them. Those who do, will find it much easier to manage the workload of Years 11 and 12 and reach their full potential.
